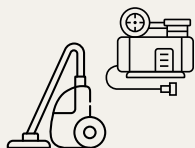


Cleaning and Maintenance Instructions

PETpanel - NXT PETpanel

With regular and careful maintenance, PETpanels will retain their appearance. Follow these four steps to safely remove dust and light soiling.

1



Removing dust

Remove dust regularly using a vacuum cleaner and a soft, clean brush. You can also gently blow the panel clean with compressed air.

2



Cleaning with water

Thanks to their open structure, PETpanels are usually easy to clean with water. Avoid harsh cleaning products to prevent damage.

3



Do not rub

Gently dab a damp PETpanel dry with a clean, colourless cotton cloth. Rubbing or scrubbing can damage the material.

4



Allow to dry properly

Allow the panel to air-dry completely. Repeat the process if necessary.

Cleaning method

By substance

Treat a stain as soon as possible. Blot up the liquid first and always work carefully.



Alcoholic drinks

Allow blotting paper to absorb the liquid. Then clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.



Coffee

Allow blotting paper to absorb the liquid. Then clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.



Blood

Rinse with cold water. Not removed completely? Clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.



Vegetables

Wash with cold water. Not completely removed? Clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.



Fruit juices

Try to remove any excess fruit. Then clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.



Ink stain

Allow blotting paper to absorb the liquid. Clean with 20% denatured alcohol. Then clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.



Chewing gum

Freeze the chewing gum using ice packs. Scrape the frozen chewing gum off the panel. Not completely removed? Clean it carefully with white spirit.



Paint

Water-based: clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water. Turpentine-based: clean with turpentine, then clean with a pH-neutral washing-up liquid and water.

Other cleaning tips

- Dab the material; do not scrub or rub.
- In most cases, clean dirt first with water and a pH-neutral washing-up liquid.
- Treat the stain as soon as possible, whilst it is still damp.
- Use a clean, colourless cotton cloth.
- Remove dust with a vacuum cleaner and a soft, clean brush.
- After using cleaning products: wipe with a damp cloth and clean water.
